

Do not place this product in direct sunlight.




Do not bend or twist the water supply hose.

The room temperature of toilet should always be above 32°F.




Do not connect to any substandard water pipe.




Clean with diluted mild dish detergent and avoid benzene, paint thinner, or nylon brush usage powdered detergents.





Before installation


- 1. For maximum effectiveness, water pressure range should be 0.1-0.75 MPa.
- 2.Stop valves should be located close to the location where this product is installed and disassembled.
- 3.Please use the braided hose that comes with the product to prevent water leakage.
- 4. When installing the braided hose, avoid letting the black gasket fall out.


Installation Procedure

1.Loosen the connecting nut and remove the old toilet seat.




Place the mounting template on the ceramic as shown. Align it with the rim of toilet.






- 3.
- a. Insert the expansion bolt into ceramic hole;
- b. Place mounting plate in notch on template;
- c. Place adjustable bracket and plastic tab in mounting plate;
- d. Align connecting bolt with expansion bolt hole, and tighten up;

4 .Slightly push the cover into fixing plate until you hear a "click", indicating that the cover has been installed in place.



5.Close the stop valve




 $\ensuremath{\mathbb{D}}$ When the toilet is similar to the figure above, we suggest connecting the straight end of the hose to the cover






②When the toilet is similar to the figure above,we suggest connecting the elbow end of the hose to the cover

8. Connecting the flexible hose




9. Open the valve to check for water leakage

10. Turn on the bidet knob to check whether the nozzle is protruding;






- 1. Do not remove internal elements of the bidet cover, otherwise mechanical failure will occur.
- **WARNING** 2. Do not connect hot water above 100°F and cold water that may lead to icing.

1. Rinse Function





Rotate knob to adjust amount of water

Note: Open the knob to the maximum level and slowly adjust down to the desired amount of water and rinsing pressure before use.


Troubleshooting

Phenomenon	Possible cause	Solution
	Knob is not completely turned on.	Increase knob regulating angle.
Low flushing	Water pressure is too low	You may need to contact a plumber to resolve
Turn on the knob and no water comes out	Valve is off	Open the valve
	The filter of the water inlet pipe is blocked	Clean the filter of the water inlet pipe
	Wand clogging	Remove the wand and clean
Spray rod cannot reset Water quality is poor and blocking the spray rod		Clean spray rod
Base leaking Water pressure is too high		You may need to contact a plumber to resolve


Cleaning and Maintenance

• Manual cleaning of spray tube

- 1. Gently pull out the wand.
- Dip a soft sponge or small brush into a mild dish detergent.
- 3. Supporting the wand, gently wipe the spray tube and wand clean.



• Clean filter screen



Tips:

- 1. Make sure that your stop valve is closed before you clean the filter screen.
- 2. Clean the filter screen.
- 3. During the cleaning process, product must be thoroughly separated from the water inlet hose.
- 4. Reinstall the filter screen in reverse order after cleaning.

• Product surface cleaning

- 1. Wipe the product surface with a sponge or soft cloth dampened with room temperature water or a mild dish detergent.
- 2. Lift the cover and seat ring when cleaning.
- 3. Do not lower the cover or seat before the cleaning agent used on the ceramic toilet is completely washed, otherwise the surface may become corroded by the evaporating toilet bowl cleaner.
